The Alpha Foundation of Howard County, Inc. and Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Kappa Phi Lambda Chapter of Columbia, MD are pleased to announce the 37th Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Breakfast. The event will be held on Sunday, January 8, 2012, at Martin's West, Baltimore, MD.

Our Breakfast serves as the major fundraiser for the Alpha Foundation of Howard County, Inc., a 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization. It is through the Foundation that Kappa Phi Lambda Chapter obtains funding to develop and implement its programs to advance the educational and quality-of-life goals of African American youth in Howard County. The Chapter's contributions include such programs as **The Alpha Achievers**, an organization of young men with 3.0 or better grade point averages with chapters in 12 Howard County high schools. It is an organization that promotes academic achievement and leadership development; **Project Alpha**, a program for young men, 12 to 15 years, that teaches responsible behavior in relationships, and provides relevant information on teen pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases; the **Ellington/Adderley-African-American Community Jazz Ensemble**, a program that pairs young musicians with seasoned veterans and the **Alpha Jaguars**, a nationally recognized AAU basketball team, The Chapter also sponsors the **Leadership Development Institute**, **Alpha Sankofa**, the **MESA Project at Cradlerock Middle School**, "Go-To-High School, Go-To-College," and "A Voteless People Is A Hopeless People." The Foundation awards at least \$10,000 annually in general scholarships to young people entering college.

Your support and participation in our Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Breakfast are critical to the Chapter's ability to maintain and expand its educational programs. Therefore, we ask that you not only purchase tickets for the Breakfast, but that you also place an ad in our 37th Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Souvenir Journal.
